

Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., Humanitarian Service Award Guidelines

The St. Bernard Hospital Community Relations Committee, on an annual basis honors an individual that exemplifies the teachings and legacy of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. while making a significant contribution to the Englewood community.

Criteria

Nominated individuals or organizations should:

1. Live, work/volunteer or operate in the primary service neighborhoods of St. Bernard Hospital: Englewood, West Englewood, Woodlawn, Auburn Gresham, Chatham, Washington Park and Greater Grand Crossing.
2. Shown visible and continued leadership in one of the following areas:
 - Education
 - Civil Rights
 - Community Service
 - Social Service
3. Has not previously received this award

Process

1. Completed nominations forms are to be submitted by noon on November 4, 2016, to the attention of:

2. The Community Relations Committee will review all applications and rank the nominees.
3. The top two (2) candidates will be selected for further review.
4. Nominating persons will be contacted for further details (where necessary).
5. The final candidate will be selected by the Community Relations Committee and approved by the Hospital's senior management team.
6. Chosen recipient and nominating party will be informed of the decision by December 31, 2016.
7. Award will be presented at the Dr. Martin Luther King celebration held on Friday January 13, 2017.

Please note that submissions received after noon on November 4, 2016 will not be considered.
